

The West Point Inn Opens New Accessible Cabin

The West Point has begun accepting reservations for the Emig cabin. This newly opened cabin is wheelchair accessible and features a private bathroom with accessible toilet, wheelchair accessible sink and roll-in/walk-in shower, a double bed and a twin bed for an assistant. Unlike the other cabins or guest rooms at the Inn, the Emig Cabin has electricity, heating, and hot water. In addition to this new cabin, there have been a number of improvements within the inn to improve accessibility for persons with disability.

Those interested in staying overnight at the Emig, or any other cabins, or in the Inn's guest rooms, need to make reservations using the West Point Inn's on-line reservation system. To facilitate the reservation process, those who have concerns about accessibility or environmental/chemical sensitivities are strongly encouraged to contact the innkeeper before making reservations, by calling 415-388-9955.
